<p><b>1. The Licensee failed to comply with O. Reg. 166/11 s. 55; Contents of records.</b></p> <p>Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection:</p> <p><b>s. 55. (5)</b> A licensee of a retirement home shall keep records proving compliance with the Act and this Regulation in relation to,</p> <p>(c) the skills, qualifications and training of the staff who work in the home.</p>
<p><b>Inspection Finding</b></p> <p>The record of training provided to staff on the following requirements was incomplete or not available: Infection Control including training on preventing cross-contamination and reporting and documenting incidents; Medication management including staff training in the administration of a drug, ways of reducing infectious diseases, including maintaining proper hand hygiene, safe disposal of syringes and sharps, recognizing an adverse drug reaction and taking appropriate action; Fire prevention and safety, complaint procedure, Resident Bill of Rights, Whistle blowing protection, PASD's .</p>
<p><b>Outcome</b></p> <p>Corrective action taken.</p>
