Purpose of Inspection
The RHRA conducts compliance inspections as set out in section 77(1) of the <i>Retirement Homes Act, 2010</i> (the "RHA").

NON-COMPLIANCE
<p>1. The Licensee failed to comply with O. Reg. 166/11, s. 27; Infection prevention and control program.</p> <p>Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):</p> <p>27. (6) The licensee of a retirement home shall ensure that each resident and the resident's substitute decision-makers, if any, are given information about how to reduce the incidence of infectious disease, including the need for and method of maintaining proper hand hygiene and the need for and process of reporting infectious illness.</p> <p>27. (7) The licensee of a retirement home shall ensure that waterless, alcohol-based hand sanitizer or another form of hand sanitation that provides equivalent protection against infectious disease transmission is available for use by residents and staff in communal resident areas and in staff work areas.</p>
<p>Inspection Finding</p> <p>At the time of the inspection, the home had not informed the residents of the need and method for proper hand hygiene. Further, the residence needed to increase the availability of hand sanitizers.</p>
<p>Outcome</p> <p>The Licensee must take corrective action to achieve compliance.</p>
<p>2. The Licensee failed to comply with O. Reg. 166/11, s. 27; Infection prevention and control program.</p>

Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):

- 27. (5)** The licensee of a retirement home shall ensure that,
- (0.b) all reasonable steps are taken in the retirement home to follow,
 - (i) any directive respecting coronavirus (COVID-19) issued to long-term care homes by the Chief Medical Officer of Health under section 77.7 of the Health Protection and Promotion Act,
 - (0.a) any guidance, advice or recommendations given to retirement homes by the Chief Medical Officer of Health are followed in the retirement home;

Inspection Finding

During the inspection it was revealed that the Licensee was not using the most current Ministry of Health screening tool did not have the policies developed in the following areas: masking and physical distancing, external care providers designation, admissions and transfers into the home, an outbreak management team, and the determination of the monthly vaccination rates for staff and residents. Additionally, a vaccine policy had not been developed and implemented.

Outcome

The Licensee must take corrective action to achieve compliance.

3. The Licensee failed to comply with O. Reg. 166/11, s. 17; Cleanliness.

Specifically, the Licensee failed to comply with the following subsection(s):

- 17. (3)** The licensee shall document the routines and methods used to comply with subsections (1) and (2).

Inspection Finding

At the time of the inspection, the Licensee was unable to produce documentation of the retirement home's cleaning routines and methods.

Outcome

The Licensee must take corrective action to achieve compliance.

NOTICE

The Final Inspection Report is being provided to the Licensee, the Registrar of the Retirement Homes Regulatory Authority (the "RHRA") and the home's Residents' Council, if any.

Section 55 of the RHA requires that the Final Inspection Report be posted in the home in a conspicuous and easily accessible location. In addition, the Licensee must ensure that copies of every Final Inspection Report from the previous two (2) years are made available in the Home, in an easily accessible location.
